TOUR

THE DUNEDIN BREWERY

Starting in 1996 (toured by ASME in 1997), several varieties of beer are brewed. Among the many varieties include an ale with a raspberry fermentation process, a year-round beer voted "Best Florida Beer" by Best Florida Beer Championship (BFBC), and the Highlands Games Ale commemorating the annual Dunedin Highland Games. Only the freshest, highest quality malt and hops are used in their hand-crafted ales and beers. Water is important, being the foundation of beer. Interestingly, the mineral profile of Dunedin's water is unique as the pure Pilsen water, allowing the flavors of the beers to emerge.

Dunedin Brewery's brewmasters will be our tour guides, fresh from their brewery conference the week before in Denver, Colorado - home of one the most environmentally innovative brewery, New Belgium Brewery Company. The Dunedin Brewery tour process includes the processes of the mash, wort, kettle, fermentation, clearing tanks, bottle labeling, bottle cleaning, and filling. After being placed in kegs or bottles and refrigerated the beer is distributed, including stores, pubs, and restaurants within the Florida West Coast area. Among the many local areas you may find or have had Dunedin Brewery's ales and beers include Bonefish Grill (Belleair), Clearwater Phillies baseball games, Publix (Clearwater, on McMullen Booth), Whistle Stop Grill (Safety Harbor), and Total Wine & More (Tampa).

Let's all enjoy the 'kick-off' of our 2010 – 2011 dinner meetings. Bring a spouse, significant other or perhaps better - a fellow engineer, to tour this brewery production process in Dunedin.
